Year 11 and 12 students can meet the requirements of the South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE) by studying English as a Second Language (ESL), specifically designed for their needs. Some schools offer special 'bridging courses' to help students reach the required level of English proficiency.

You should note, however, that all schools prefer, and some require, students to sit an English test prior to enrolment. Students who do not satisfy the general English proficiency requirements for entry may undertake an English Language Intensive Course for Overseas Students (ELICOS) program. All schools can arrange entry into such a program.

**Healthy mind, healthy body** – Your child will be encouraged to have a balanced lifestyle, maintain health, fitness and overall well-being. Extensive extra-curricular activities are offered at all schools, including a range of sports and community activities.

**The path to higher education and training** – As skills are honed and academic goals are reached, so your child can look forward to individual guidance to assist in choices for their future. School completion in Australia requires a balance of subjects to ensure a complete education. Students in Years 11 and 12 study for the South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE); a number of schools also offer the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma. 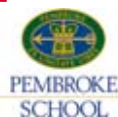
